### **Donation for the non-profit organization Salem International and Tukulere Wamu**

The charitable organization Salem International and the association Tukulere Wamu are pleased about a donation of 4,166 euros. The staff and the works council of Schölly Fiberoptic GmbH laid the foundation for this amount during the Christmas collection 2021. The sum was doubled by a private donation from Regula Schölly.
