Stefan Schnekenburger expands the Executive Board and will become chairman

As of September 1, 2023, Stefan Schnekenburger expands the Executive Board of Schölly Fiberoptic GmbH and takes over the chairmanship from Prof. Dr. Holger Reinecke.
